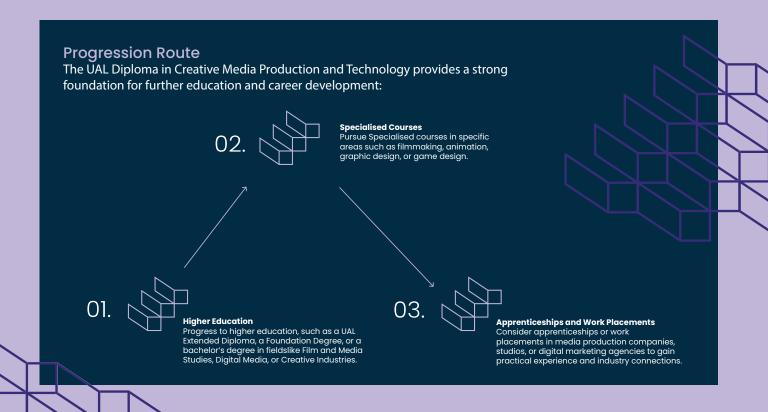
Understand the creative process from concept to completion. Explore idea development, project planning, scriptwriting, and storyboarding.
